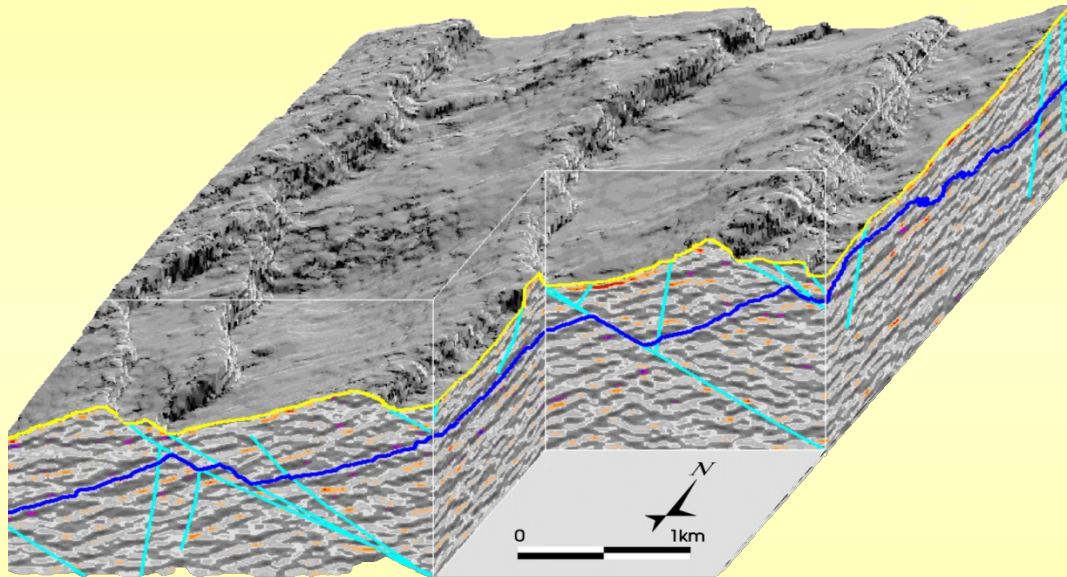
Awards

- **Total yearly budget is 4 MNOK**

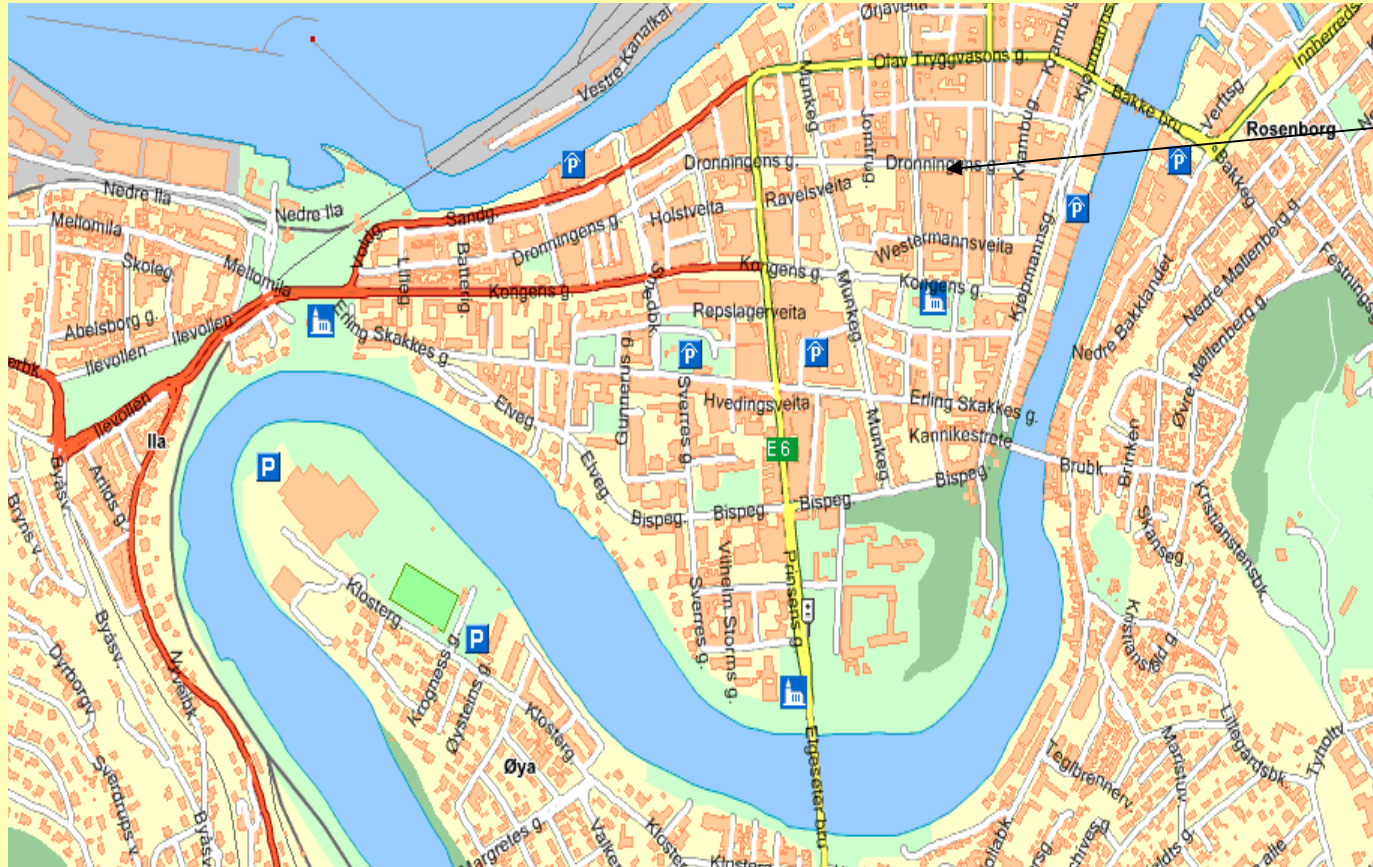
